This Summer Intensive Study Program will lay emphasis on **history of psychology, fundamentals of Analytical Psychology, dreams, myths and fairy tales, individuation, typology, religion, active imagination, art, body work and science.**

In addition to the regular lectures and the special seminars, the curator of the **Institute's Picture Archives** will meet with the ISP students and show some examples from the extensive collection. There will be excursions organised to **a site of historic importance for analytical psychology** and to the **baroque monastery in Einsiedeln with the famous Black Madonna.**

The Summer Intensive Study Program provides an excellent opportunity for an exchange of thoughts and social contacts among the Institute's students and participants of different geographical and professional backgrounds.

It is intended that lectures, seminars and discussions can be followed by those with a limited background in Jungian Psychology, but will at the same time be of value to those with professional psychological training and interests. The courses are taught by analysts of the Institute and internationally renowned guest lecturers.
